ABSTRACT

As a kind of tourist attraction, jogging track attraction is a sports facility located in rice fields, where tourists can feel cool and fresh atmosphere. Those potential is also supported by the planning and activities of the stakeholders in order to develop this tourism for society and tourists in realizing the jogging track tourist attraction. The purposes of this research are: 1) to discover the potential of Anggabaya village, Penatih Denpasar in which has the opportunity to develop jogging track attraction. 2) to describe the impact caused by the development of jogging track as tourist attraction on the economic, social and cultural aspects of the society in Anggabaya village, Penatih Denpasar.
